

LISTED BREEDS

As many exhibitors will be aware, the Canadian Kennel Club has held a poll of its members to obtain their input into allowing additional breeds to participate at CKC sanctioned shows and events. As of January 10, 2007 the following breeds are permitted to participate in CKC sanctioned Conformation Shows as a "Listed Breed" [Anatolian Shepherd Dog](#), [Australian Kelpie](#), [Black Russian Terrier](#), [Finnish Lapphund](#), [Kleiner Munsterlander](#), [Mudi](#), [Shikoku](#), [Tatra Shepherd Dog](#), [Tibetan Mastiff](#).

These breeds will also be allowed to continue to enter and participate in the entire Rare Breed Club of South Western Ontario shows and events until such time as they are moved to the list of CKC "Approved Breeds". All points earned previously at our shows and those in the future will be awarded to the dog earning such points.

The only change that has occurred with this action by the Canadian kennel Club is to allow additional breeds to participate in their sanctioned shows. There will be no change or alterations to these breeds as far as participating in our club's activities.

We look forward to seeing all of our previous exhibitors with these breeds at our shows and wish them well if they choose to participate in CKC sanctioned events. The benefit to these breeds is not only an increase in their exposure to the canine fancy but they will also be able to participate in both our club's shows and events and the CKC sanctioned shows where we hold our shows in conjunction with CKC sanctioned clubs.
